CORPORATE DISCOUNTS

What is it?

The purpose of the corporate rebate project is to enable NAQ Outarouais community members whose dues are up to date to obtain rebates on purchases at participating merchants.

How it works

When you make a purchase at a participating business, you must ask for the discount at the cash register before paying :

Present your NAQ card and community discount card and ask for the discount that has been approved by the business.

We are mindful that it will take some time before all employees are familiar with the rebate project. It is therefore important to ask for a manager if there is any difficulty. AND PLEASE inform us of any problems you encounter so that we can resolve them.
